

Waiver - 15 minute Observation Period for patients' 11yo+

Anderson Hills Pediatrics recommends Immunizations as endorsed by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP). Fainting, feeling dizzy or feeling lightheaded rarely occurs after vaccination and is most common among adolescents and young adults. For this reason a 15 minute period of observation in the office will routinely be performed after vaccination of children 11 years of age and older. I am aware of the risks which include but are not limited to: fainting, head injury caused by fall, etc. and decline to have my child observed in the office 15 minutes post vaccine. ** Patients' who drive themselves are required to wait the 15 minute observation period and may not opt out by signing a waiver.
